Introduction

This guide describes how to download SpaceMan 99 from the ExtraBit web site, and install it on your computer.

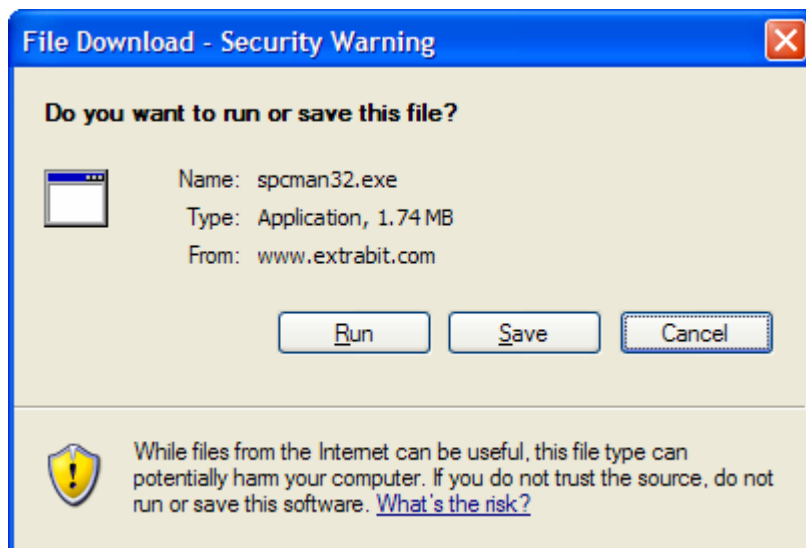
SpaceMan 99 is a tool for showing the total amount of disk space used by folders, and for finding duplicate files and folders. For more information, visit <http://www.extrabit.com/spaceman99>.

Downloading SpaceMan 99

The first step is to download SpaceMan 99. If you already have the file **spcman32.exe** from another source, such as a magazine cover disk, then you can skip this step.

The easiest way to download SpaceMan 99 is to go the ExtraBit web site at www.extrabit.com, and select the **Download Now** link in the SpaceMan 99 section. Alternatively, you can enter the following link directly into your browser's address box: www.extrabit.com/downloads/spcman32.exe

You will see a panel like the following. This may vary slightly depending on the browser and version of Windows you are using. The following image shows the panel when using Internet Explorer 7 and Windows XP.



Don't worry about the warning, this is normal when any program is downloaded.

The simplest option to choose is **Run**. This will download the SpaceMan 99 installer to a temporary folder, from where it will be run automatically once it has downloaded.

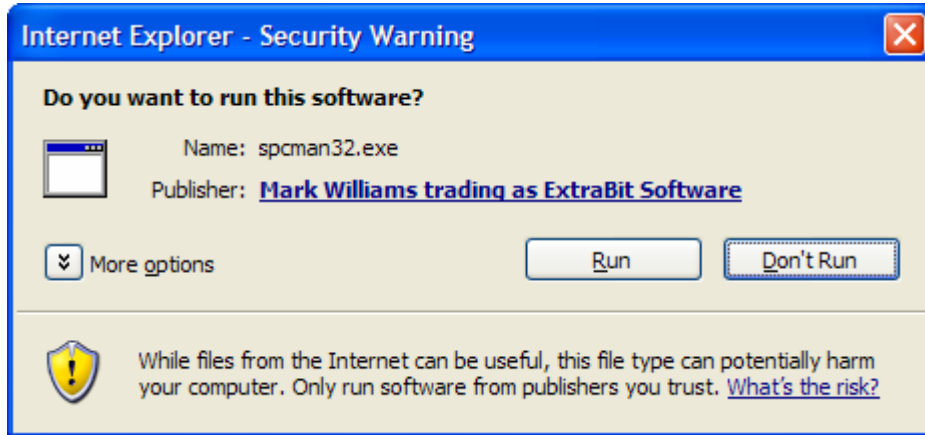
Alternatively, you could select **Save**. This will bring up a file save dialog. If you choose this option you will have to select the folder where the SpaceMan 99 will be downloaded to. Once it has been downloaded, you will have to use Windows Explorer to find this folder again, and then look for the file **spcman32.exe**, which is the SpaceMan 99 installer.

Running the installer

If you have downloaded SpaceMan 99 and selected the **Run** option, the installer will run automatically.

Otherwise, you need to run the installer by finding the file **spcman32.exe** using Windows Explorer, and double clicking on this file to run it.

Before the installer runs, you will see a panel like this:



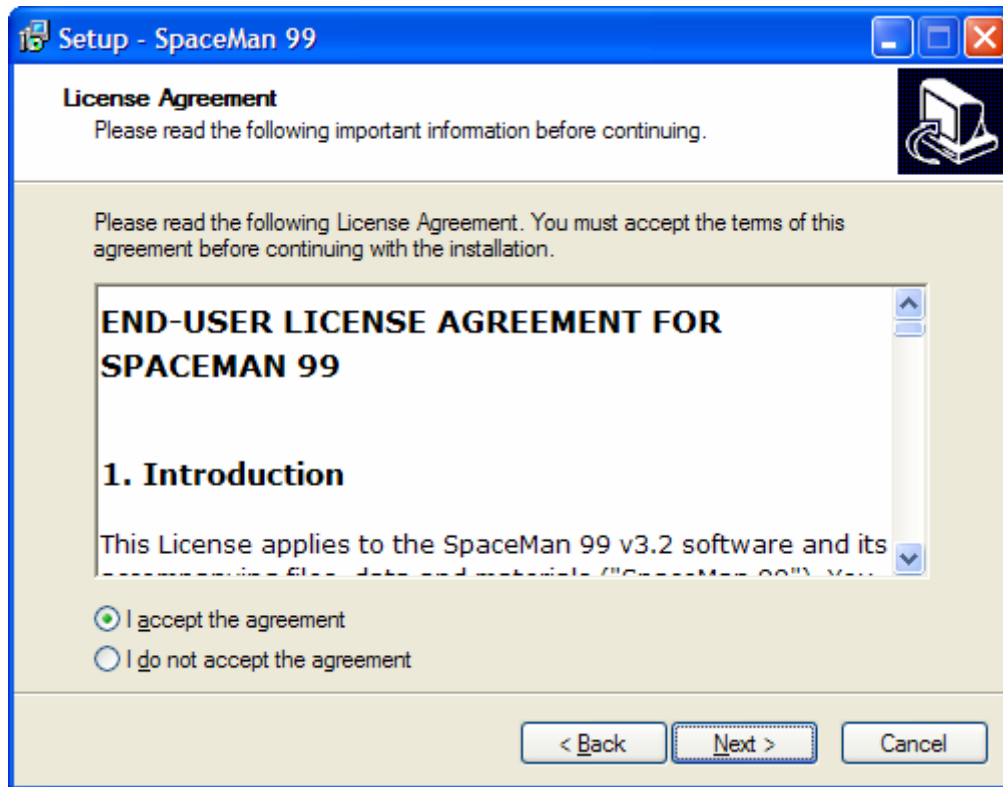
Press **Run** to run the installer.

The installer will then unpack the installation files and start the installation. This may take a few seconds. Once the installation starts, you will see this panel:



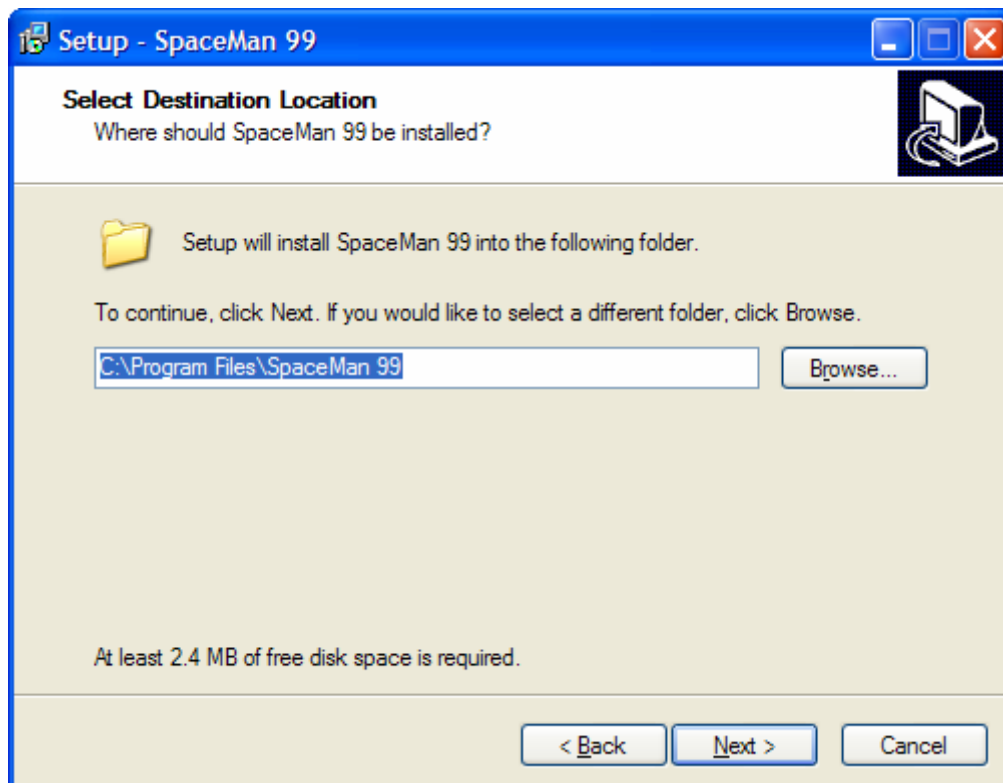
Press the **Next** button.

You will then be shown the license agreement for SpaceMan 99.



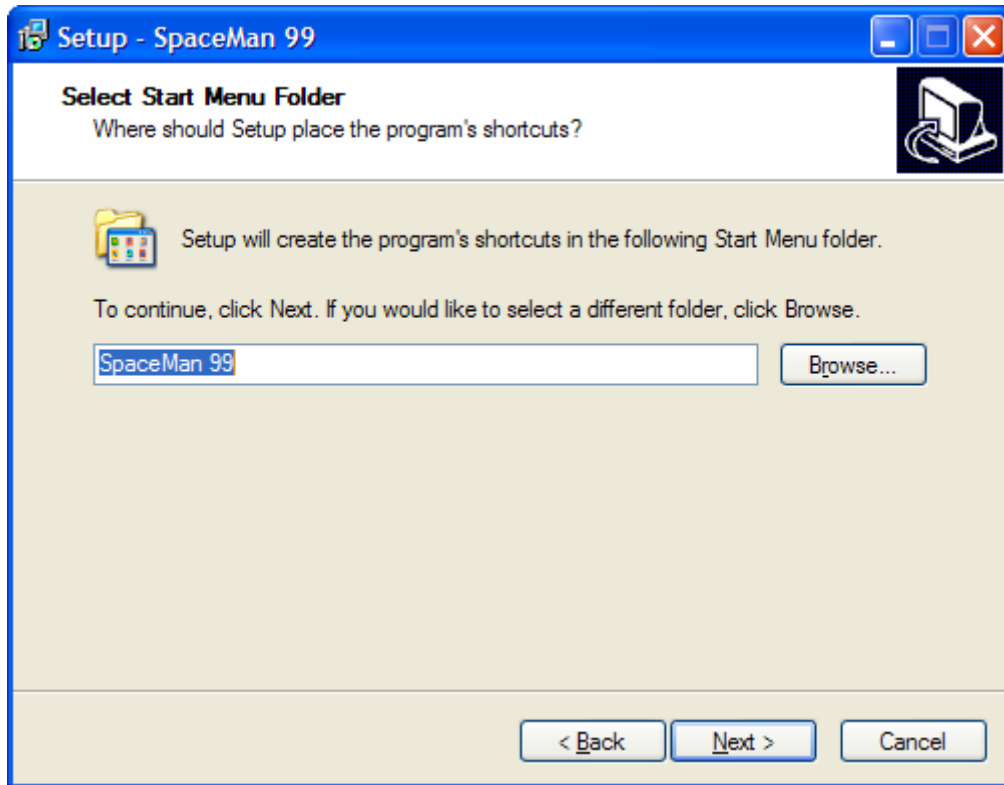
You must select “I accept the agreement” to agree to these terms before the installation will continue. If you do not agree to the terms, press the **Cancel** button, and the installation will be aborted.

You will then see the following panel:



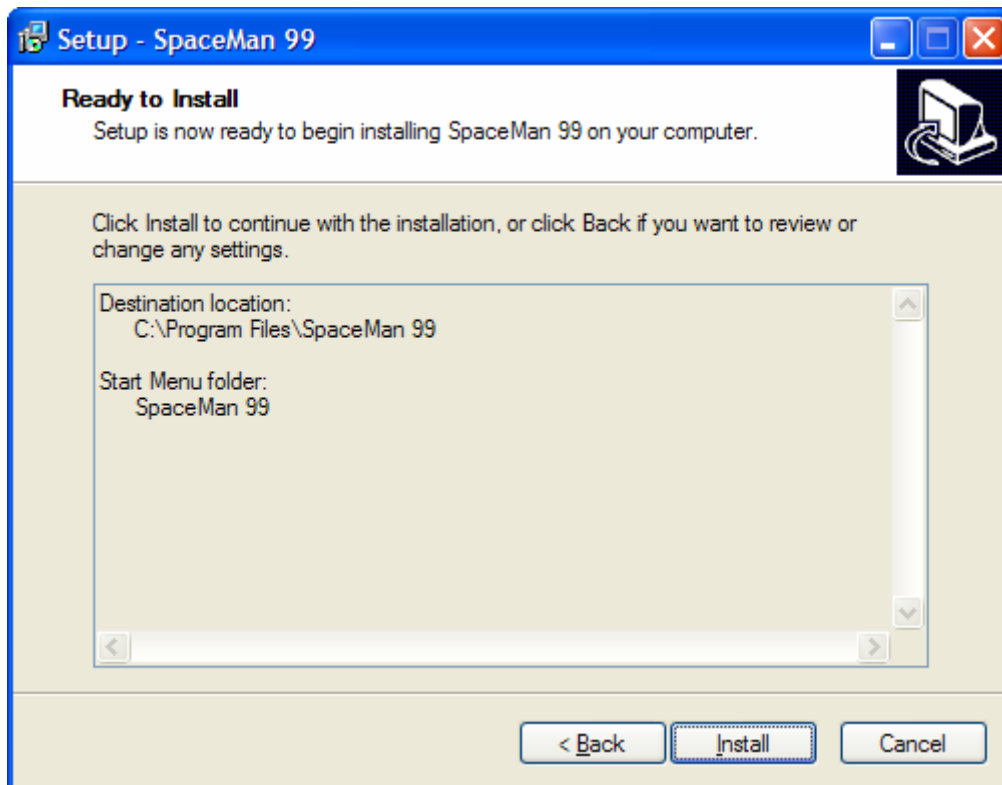
This allows you to select the folder where SpaceMan 99 will be installed. Unless you have a particular reason not to, it is best to accept the default.

Press the **Next** button to advance to this panel:



This panel allows you to set where SpaceMan 99 will be included in your Start menu. By default, a new menu item called SpaceMan 99 will be created. You can change this by typing a new name, or by selecting one of the existing menu items to put it under.

Press the **Next** button, and you will see this screen that confirms the selections you have made.



Press the **Install** button to start installing the files. This should only take a few seconds, then you will see this panel once it has finished.



At this point, SpaceMan 99 is installed on your computer.

Press **Finish** to close the installer program. If you have left “Launch SpaceMan 99” checked, SpaceMan 99 will automatically launch.

Running SpaceMan 99

Once SpaceMan 99 has been installed, there are two ways to launch it.

From the Windows Start menu

Like most programs, SpaceMan 99 can be run from the Windows **Start** menu. From the **Start** menu, under **Programs**, you will find SpaceMan 99 under the start menu item you selected when you installed it. By default, this is **SpaceMan 99**, and under this you will find the menu item to launch SpaceMan 99 itself.

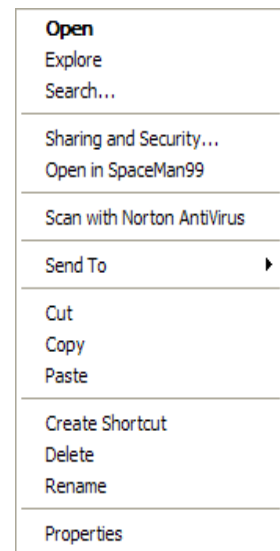
From the Windows Explorer context menu

An alternative way to launch SpaceMan 99 is from the Windows Explorer context menu. This is useful if you have been using Windows Explorer to browse the file system, and you already have the folder you want to scan open in Windows Explorer.

The simplest way to run Windows Explorer is to double click on the **My Computer** icon on your desktop. When you right click on a folder in Windows Explorer, you will see a menu similar to the one shown here.

You may not see exactly the same items, depending on the software you have installed on your computer. However, if you select **Open in SpaceMan 99**, this will launch SpaceMan 99 with the folder already selected in SpaceMan 99.

i **Open in SpaceMan 99** only appears in this menu when you right click on a folder in Windows Explorer, if you right click on a file you will not see this option.



Entering the license token

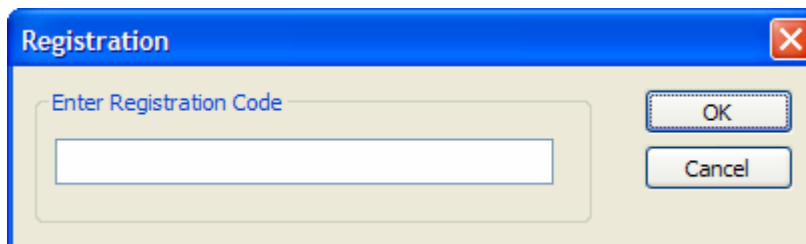
When SpaceMan 99 is installed, it will be in 30-day trial mode. The only difference between this and the full mode is that when it is launched, you will see this panel:



After 30 days, you will be unable to use SpaceMan 99 unless you buy a license token.

During the 30 day trial period, SpaceMan 99 is fully functional, so can you try out all the features it has. This means that if you choose to buy SpaceMan 99 you know exactly what you will be getting.

When you buy SpaceMan 99, you will receive a registration code. To enter the registration code, press the **Register** button on the panel shown above. You will then see this panel:



Enter the license token and press **OK**.

Provided you have entered a valid token, SpaceMan 99 will then be registered and the 30-day trial mode will be removed. You will no longer see the trial mode panel when SpaceMan 99 is started.

Uninstalling SpaceMan 99

To uninstall SpaceMan 99:

- From the Windows **Start** menu, select the **Control Panel**.
- From this, select **Add or Remove Programs**.
- Select **SpaceMan 99** from the list of installed programs, and press the **Remove** button.
- Select **Yes** from the confirmation panel, and SpaceMan 99 will be removed from your computer.
